**WHEN:** February 23-25, 2024

WHERE: Georgia World Congress Center – Atlanta, Georgia

WHAT: An open gymnastics competition for athletes with disabilities and unified partners.

- LOCAL HOSTS: Paws for a Cause Invitational Chattooga Gymnastics, Special Olympics Georgia, and Cobb County Special Olympics Gymnastics Team
- EVENTS:Rhythmic Gymnastics (Individual, Group, Unified) Artistic<br/>Gymnastics (Men, Women, Unified)<br/>NOTE Men will compete 4 events: Floor, Vault, Pommel Horse & Parallel Bars

## **REQUIREMENTS:**

- All HUGS Artistic and HUGS Rhythmic competitors must have a current USA Gymnastics athlete membership.
- Coaches with athletes competing in HUGS events must have a USA Gymnastics Professional Membership.
- AAU Special Stars competitors must have a current AAU membership.
- Coaches with athletes competing in Special Stars events must have an AAU membership.
- Special Olympics competitors must have a current medical and release on file with their Program office (local/state/provincial/national). Unified partners are required to have the same membership/documentation, as their special needs partner.
- Coaches for Special Olympics disciplines must submit a signed confirmation letter from the program office with each entry.

## **COMPETITION FORMAT:**

RHYTHMIC GYMNASTICS – Athletes have 2 choices for competition: Special Olympics & USA Gymnastics HUGS. Rules for competition & awards will follow either Special Olympics or HUGS guidelines. Coaches should enter athletes on the appropriate Entry Form for either SO or HUGS. Separate sessions will be run for each. Unified is offered for all levels.

- MEN'S & WOMEN'S ARTISTIC GYMNASTICS Male athletes have 2 choices for competition: Special Olympics & USA Gymnastics HUGS. Rules for competition & awards will follow either Special Olympics or HUGS guidelines. Female athletes have 3 choices for competition: Special Olympics, USA Gymnastics HUGS and AAU Special Stars. Coaches should enter athletes on the appropriate Entry Form for either SO, HUGS or AAU. Separate sessions will be run for each. Unified is offered for all levels.
- GALA During the competition on Saturday, February 24, all teams are invited to perform an exhibition routine in the Gala (3 minute maximum). The Gala will be held on the rhythmic floor, so artistic equipment will not be available.

- Athletes may enter two disciplines (Rhythmic, Artistic)
- Entry fee: \$75 for one discipline, \$105 for two disciplines
- Entry deadline: January 6, 2024
